June 2022 Report

The El Dorado Hills Fire Department, Community Risk Reduction Division (CRRD) continues to see significant residential development and vegetation management program activity throughout the reporting period. Major construction activity is occurring in the Saratoga Estates, Carson Creek, Bell Ranch, Hawk View, and Bass Lake North areas of the District. New commercial construction consisting of Tractor Supply in the Business Park area, a hotel in Town Center, as well as the training center is also ongoing.

CRRD has received a total of **631** permit to construct plan review submittals since January 1, 2022. Home construction permit activity was the leading permit submittal type with **310** plan applications received followed by **140** fire protection system applications and **114** miscellaneous applications.

CRRD completed **350** vacant lot inspections throughout the District. CRRD also investigated **12** Defensible Space citizen complaints on behalf of the County of El Dorado as part of their Vegetation Management program. CRRD staff additionally provided defensible space education to members of the Union Mine and Rescue communities as part of the 2022 County Emphasis Areas.

MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

CRRD staff completed the following activities during the last 30 days:

- Completed **170** construction inspections and **191** smoke and carbon monoxide alarm inspections.
- Completed **30** fire and life safety inspections of residential and commercial occupancies.
- Completed **350** vacant lot and **12** defensible space inspections.
- Assisted Lake Valley Fire Protection District in completing **40** defensible space inspections.
- Completed **2** defensible space public education events in the Union Mine and Rescue County Enforcement Areas.
- Staff continues to work with vendors on upgrading our existing records management systems (RMS) to improve customer satisfaction and streamlining permit processes.

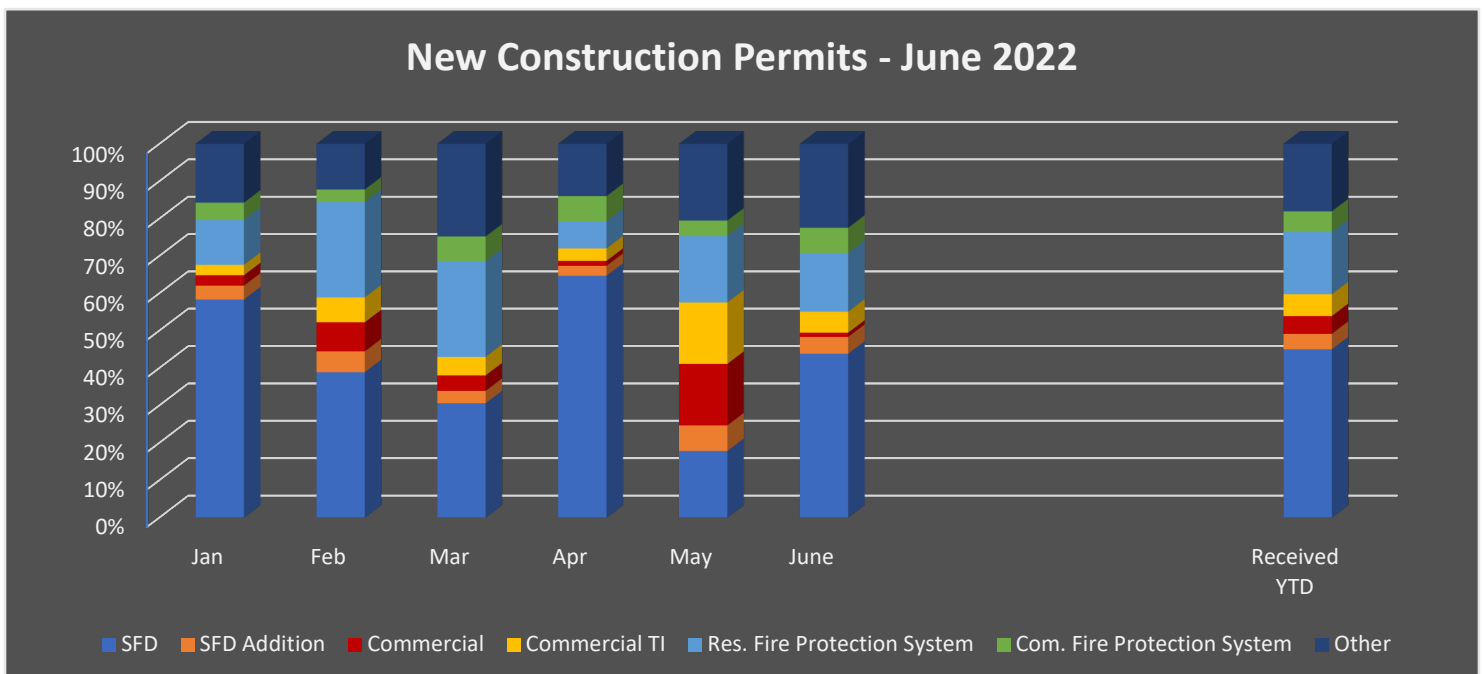
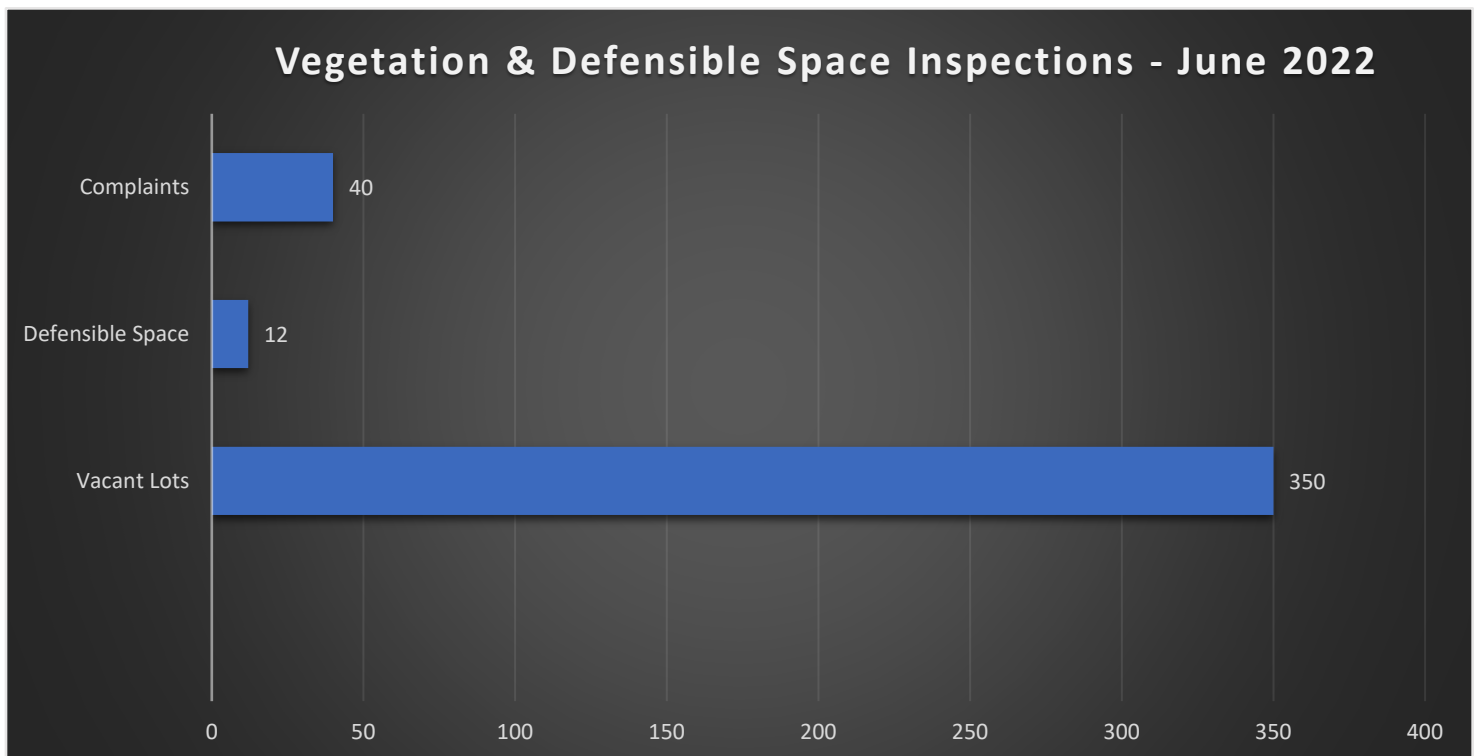


Table 2: Fire and Life Safety Inspections by Month Report
