SUBJECT: Fire Equipment Mechanic Vehicle Purchase Update

TOPIC

Staff seeks Board authorization to modify the purchase of the new fire equipment mechanic vehicle.

SUMMARY

At the February 17, 2022, Board meeting, the Board authorized the purchase of a new fire equipment mechanic vehicle, utilizing a contract from the City of Marysville for a similar vehicle build with Lodi Truck and Equipment ("Lodi").

The contract with Lodi was executed, and staff selected a Ford Motor Company chassis. At that time, Lodi advised they would deliver the completed vehicle by June 2022. Lodi has since informed us that they have not been able to secure the chassis in the near term and discussed the potential for the order to be canceled. Commercial truck chassis supply is extremely limited due to current manufacturing issues, and chassis are simply unavailable to our vendor. Lodi has stated that they will honor the "build up" portion of our agreement if we are able to secure a chassis and reduce the cost of our contract with them for that portion.

Staff has been unsuccessful in locating a Ford chassis but has located a used 2020 Ram chassis in Utah which is equivalent in capacity and performance to the Ford chassis. The Ram chassis would be purchased directly from the dealer at a cost of \$80,515.66. The Department will receive a reduction in the contract amount with Lodi respective to the cost of the Ford Chassis in the amount of \$61,702.00. The difference between the original Ford chassis cost and the proposed Ram chassis cost is an increase of \$24,651.05. Lodi has agreed to honor all other portions of its bid.

Staff has contacted multiple vehicle dealerships, Enterprise Fleet, as well as Sourcewell, the vendor currently being used for the Battalion Chief vehicle conversion. All dealers/vendors contacted were unsuccessful in locating a vehicle. Staff has been advised that the market is experiencing lengthy delays from the time of order and unprecedented cancelations from all manufacturers. Evident from the experience that vehicles have been ordered for 6 to 10 months, only to be canceled.

Staff has consulted with legal counsel and has confirmed that based on Lodi's claim that they are unable to comply with the original contract terms, the Department is justified in utilizing sole source procurement of the chassis and modifying its contract with Lodi accordingly. The other alternative is to terminate our agreement with Lodi and enter into a new contract for the vehicle when supply issues have stabilized.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Board originally approved a not to exceed amount of \$210,000 for this purchase and that is reflected in the approved 2022/23 Preliminary Budget. The table below outlines the proposed adjusted cost of this purchase, which would be updated in the final version of the 2022/23 Budget:

Staff recommends the Board approve the updated agreement with Lodi Truck and Equipment for vehicle conversion and authorize the purchase of the chassis directly from the dealer not to exceed \$225,000.00.

SUBJECT: Deputy Chief Command Vehicle Conversions

TOPIC

Staff seeks Board authorization to purchase two (2) Deputy Chief Command vehicle conversions.

SUMMARY

At the July 21, 2022, Board meeting, the Board authorized the purchase of two (2) new Deputy Chief vehicle chassis directly from a dealership. These vehicle purchases were approved in the 2022/23 Preliminary Budget.

Staff has evaluated the need for this command vehicle conversion, as well as the available options and post-purchase customer service of potential vendors. Staff also considered the need for consistency with operational standards relative to the functionality of its vehicles, including future maintenance of the new technology available. Staff determined that 911 Vehicle, which is currently the vendor contracted to build the Department's Battalion Chief Command vehicle, would be the best vendor to select for the build of the Deputy Chief vehicles as well.

Consistent with the District's procurement policy, we are able to utilize an existing public contract with Sourcewell, National Auto Fleet Group, which went through a competitive bid process for the same type of vehicle build. The Sourcewell master vehicle contract that is being utilized is contract number 091521-NAF.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Board originally approved \$200,000 for the purchase and command conversion of both Deputy Chief vehicles, which is reflected in the approved 2022/23 Preliminary Budget. The final budget adjustment, including the purchase of the vehicles approved at the July Board meeting, will be \$135,617.60. The table below outlines the proposed adjusted cost of this purchase, which would be updated in the final version of the 2022/23 Budget:
