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This amendment is to the Wildfire Fire Safe Plan, October, 2005. All other conditions not specified in this amendment remain in effect.

In the original plan, the Wildfire Mitigation Measures required that Lots 34, 35, 56, and 57 have noncombustible fences along the open space with pedestrian gates. It has been determined that the pedestrian gate is not necessary for these four lots. These lots border the open space and emergency vehicle access is adjacent to these lots. Lots 34 and 35 border Open Space B and Lots 56 and 57 borders Open Space A (see attached map).

Wildfire Mitigation Measures required that Lots 28-31 have a 30 foot setback from the rear property line. This was due to the belief that these Lots were adjacent to wildland area. These Lots in fact, back up to existing lots in another development. The setback requirement is not appropriate (see attached map).
